## Structure and Content

1. Of the 360 points required for this degree, a student must pass:
  - a. At least 300 points from courses listed in the Bachelor of Dance Studies Schedule, including:
    - i. At least 180 points above Stage One, of which at least 90 points must be above Stage Two.
    - b. 30 points from courses listed in the General Education schedule approved for this degree.
2. Up to 30 points may be taken from courses available for any other Bachelors degree at The University of Auckland.
