# Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) Degree Planner

## Structure and Content

1. Of the 480 points required for this degree, a student must pass:
  - a. At least 450 points from courses listed in the Bachelor of Fine Arts Schedule.
  - b. 30 points from courses offered in the General Education Schedule approved for this degree.
2. a. A student must pass each of Years One, Two, Three and Four as listed in the Bachelor of Fine Arts Schedule.
  - i. A student will not normally be permitted to enrol for Year Two unless Year One has been completed, nor to enrol for Year Three unless Year Two has been completed, nor to enrol for Year Four unless Year Three has been completed.
  - ii. However, a student who has failed to pass one of those years in its entirety may be allowed at the discretion of Senate or its representative, to enrol for the course or courses needed to complete that Year together with a course or courses towards the next year.
  - iii. Only in exceptional circumstances will a student be permitted to enrol for Year Three unless Year One has been completed, or to enrol for Year Four unless Year Two has been completed.
  - iv. A student will not be permitted to enrol for Year Four if they have not completed the requirements listed in Regulation 1b.
