Pre-Audition CD/DVD Requirements

All applicants are required to submit a CD/DVD or video recording of themselves performing two or three original songs written by them in the past two years. For each song the applicant must be the principal singer and instrumentalist playing either guitar or piano/keyboard. An audition/interview will be requested based upon the outcome of the pre-audition CD/DVD. Auditions are held from the last week of October onwards.

Curriculum Vitae (CV) Requirements

- Performing experience, such as public performances and any other participation in musical activities.
- Musical qualifications (eg, AMusA, LTCL, PerfCert, Royal Schools, Trinity College). Please list the highest grade achieved, the instrument (if applicable) and attach a certified copy of the certificate.
- Music Teachers—Please list their names, city, and the instrument and years in which you studied under them.
- A short report from a suitable person (such as a music teacher or school principal) about you, your musical work and your suitability for study in Popular Music at The University of Auckland.
